We will work with **corrugated fibreboard**, **honeycomb fibreboard**, **plywood**, or a **combination of two or more materials** to manufacture the optimum packaging for each customer's supply chain



Here is an example of a multi-material packaging solution for road freight:

- · A honeycomb lid with plywood insert.
- Honeycomb sides with octagon plywood insert to accommodate a Fibre IBC from our preferred supplier
- · Integrated honeycomb base with plywood insert

Our Materials



Corrugated Fibreboard

- Also known as corrugated cardboard.
- Made from cellulose fibres, usually a mix of virgin & recycled fibres.
- · Extremely lightweight material.
- Kimmo uses double-walled corrugated sheets comprising of 3 liners separated by 2 layers of fluting.



Honeycomb Fibreboard

- Hexagonal inner cellulose structure sandwiched between specially treated boards.
- Takes its name from the visual resemblance to a bee's honeycomb.
- · Lightweight but very durable.
- Kimmo specialises in the use of honeycomb fibreboard.



Plywood

- Man-made material manufactured from thin layers of wood.
- A lightweight, durable material.
- The layers are glued together with adjacent layers, with the wood grain rotated up to 90° to one another (known as cross-graining).
- Cross-graining improves strength and creates durable packaging products.
